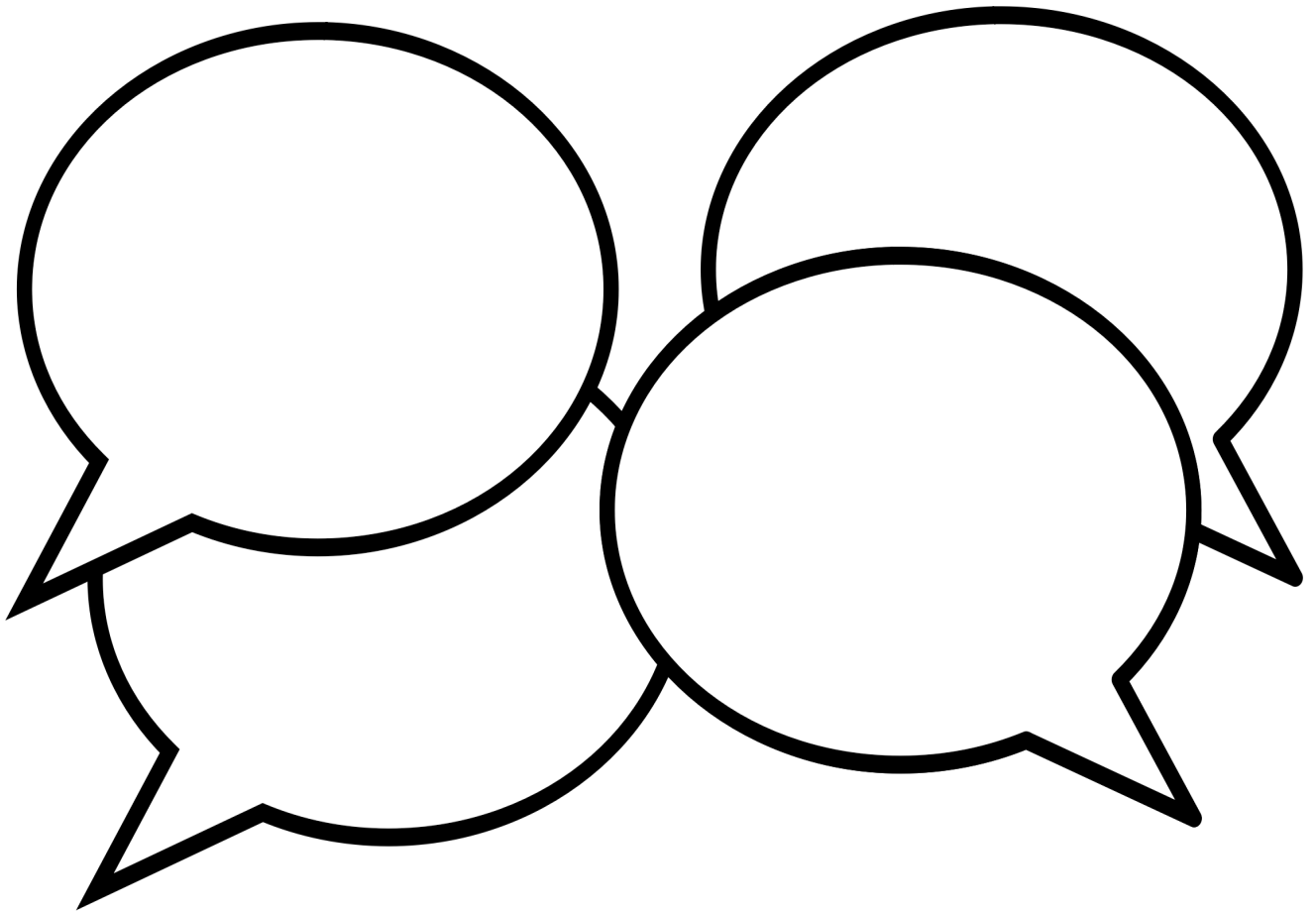


Putting My Hand Up to Speak

discussions

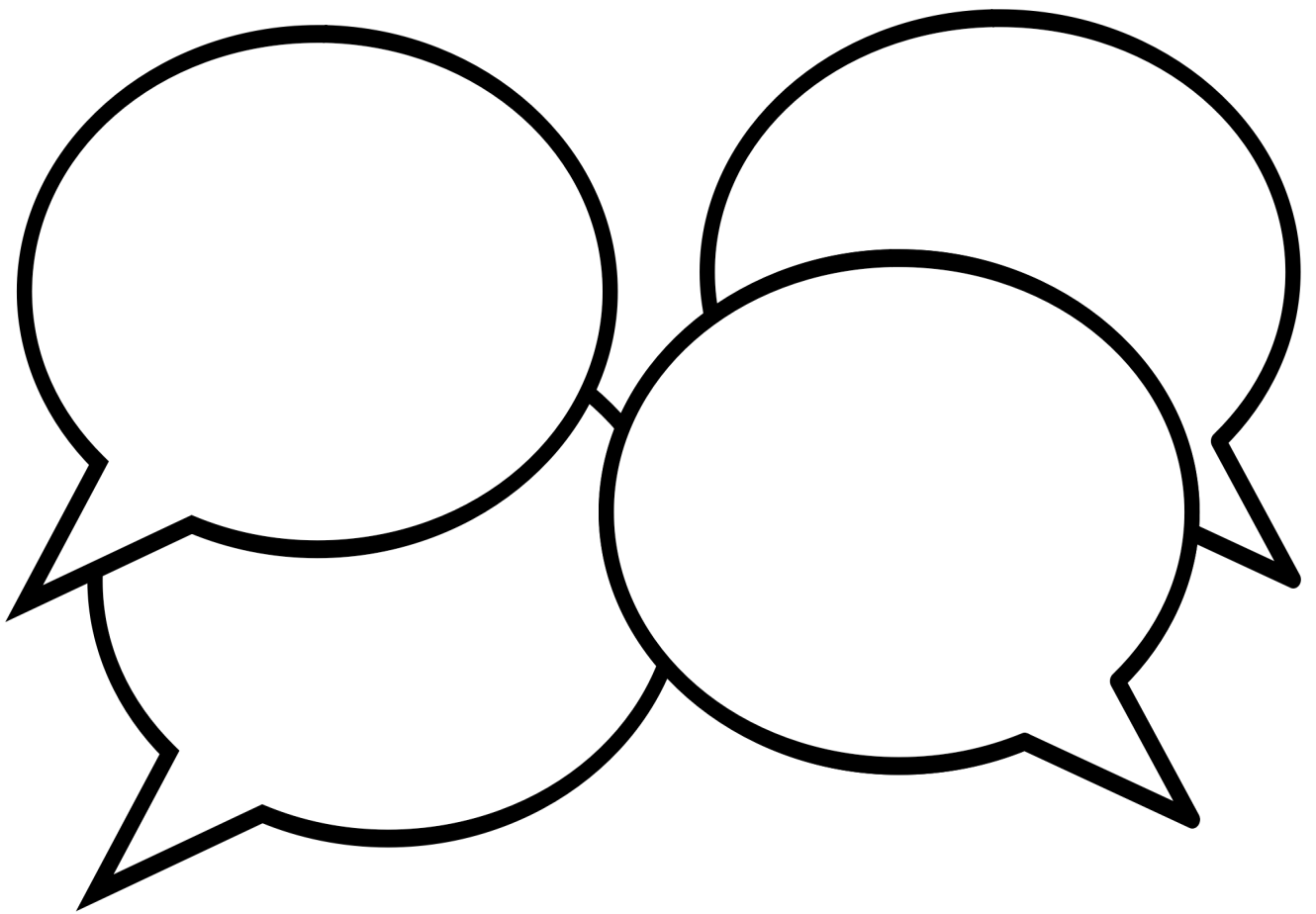


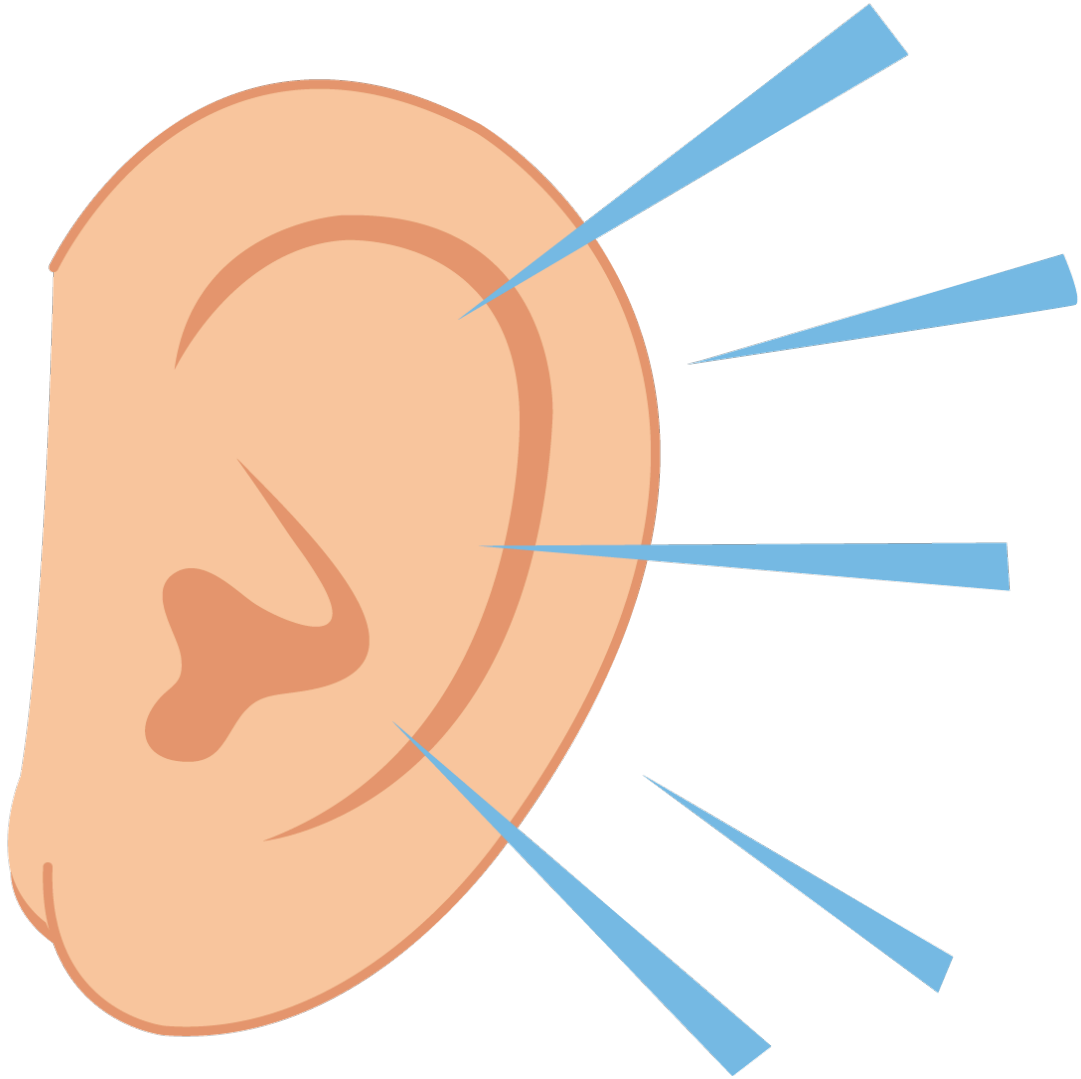
I think I have really

when I answer questions.

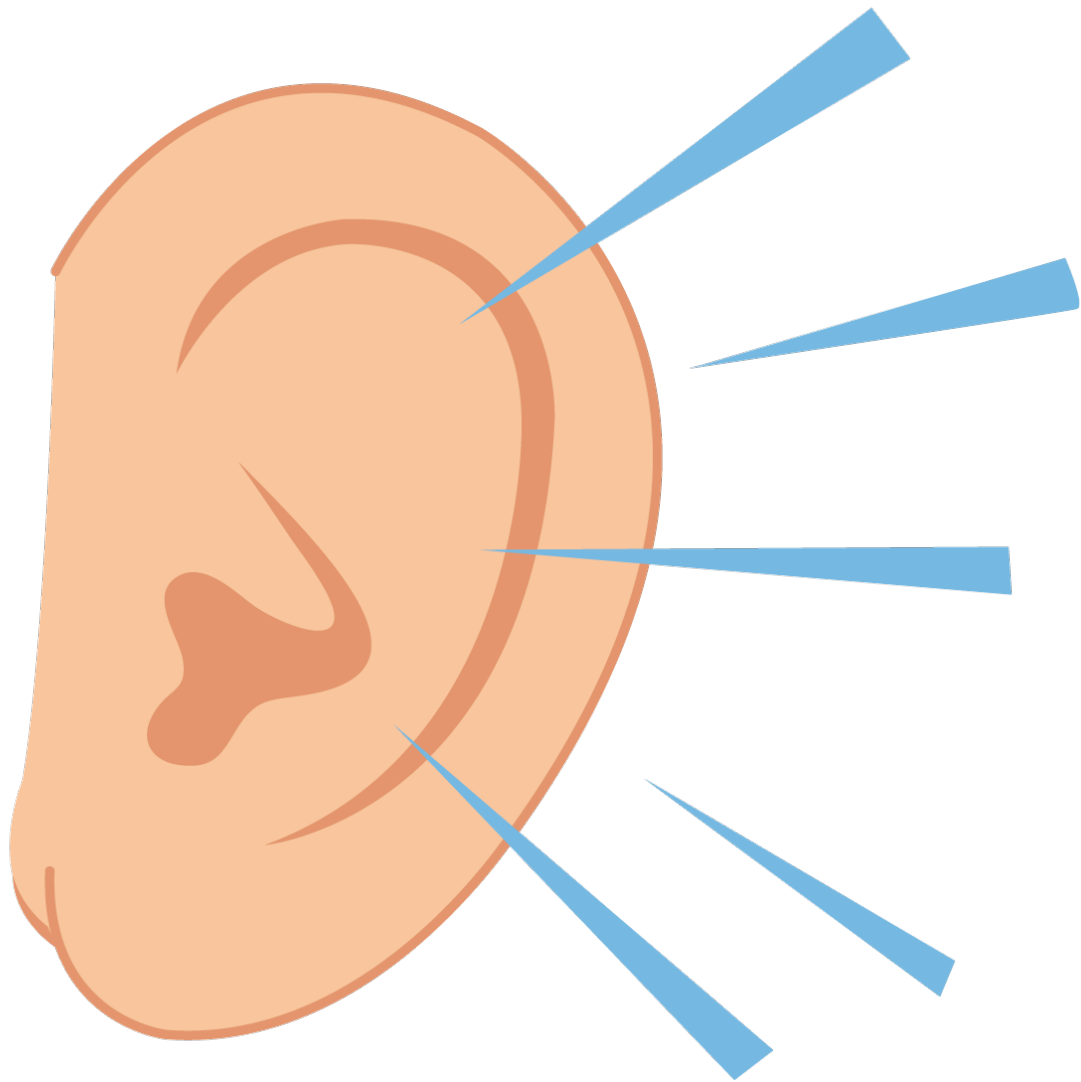
However other children in
